The class websites will have information like lesson plans, materials and assignments. Please contact me if there is anything you need or if you have any questions or concerns during the following school hours: Mondays-Friday 7:30-8:00 AM and 3:40- 4:30. Art from exhibits must be picked up from the school after the show. Students will take formative and summative evaluations of personal art. We will explore 5 different types of media, use rubrics, draw using value and proportions, learn about careers in art, write a descriptive essay and learn how to study using art.
